The faculty are encouraged with research funding in the following categories:

1. Indian book chapters publications: Staff are encouraged to publish more chapters and seed amount will be provided only for two chapters.
2. International book chapters publications: Only one publication per staff per year.
3. Publications of UGC Care list journals: Seed amount will be provided only for two publications.
4. Scopus papers: Only one paper per staff is eligible to receive seed amount.
5. Conference proceedings: Seed money limited to 2 per year.
6. Books publications: Seed money limited to 1 book per year.

Nazareth College of Arts & Science in Avadi has adopted five villages in Thiruvallur District, aiming to improve living conditions and provide essential services through various interventions. The initiative involves conducting comprehensive surveys and observations to identify the primary needs and challenges faced by the villagers and develop sustainable development plans tailored to each village.

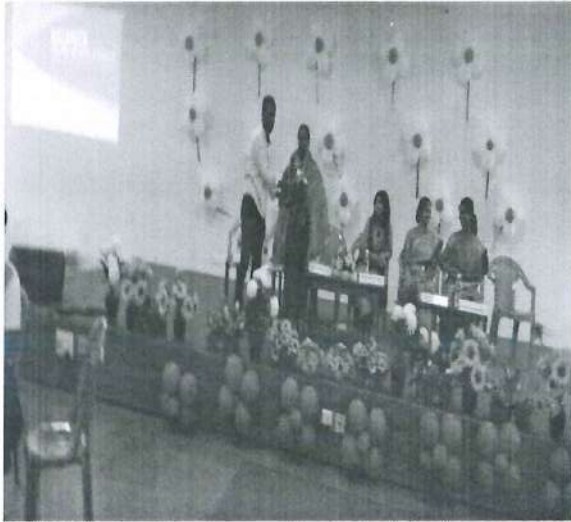

The terrace garden was renovated in the years 2021–2022.

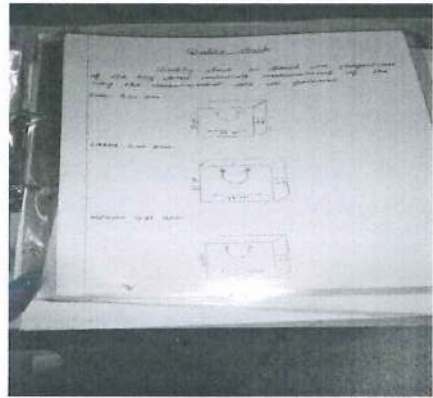
Seed Ball Production:-

REPORT

On March 27, 2024, the IIC of Nazareth College of Arts & Science in collaboration with the Department of Computer Science, conducted an event titled "Workshop on Prototype Design and Development" at 10 am. The event began with the welcome address and chief guest introduction. The workshop by the distinguished chief guest was Mr T Akash, IIM, Trichy.

The objective of the "Prototype Design and Development" workshop, featured by Mr. T Akash, was to impart a comprehensive understanding of the five phases of design thinking and to equip participants with practical skills for transforming ideas into tangible prototypes through interactive examples and hands-on experience. Around 90 students and 3 staff participated in the event.

Mr. T Akash masterfully commenced the session by introducing the concept of design thinking, emphasizing its critical role in today's innovation-driven landscape. He focused on the workshop's objective, that to not only impart theoretical knowledge but also to provide hands-on insights into bringing an idea to life through the disciplined approach of design thinking.

Five Phases of Design Thinking: The crux of the workshop revolved around the five phases of design thinking, which Mr. Akash elaborated upon with great detail and engaging examples:

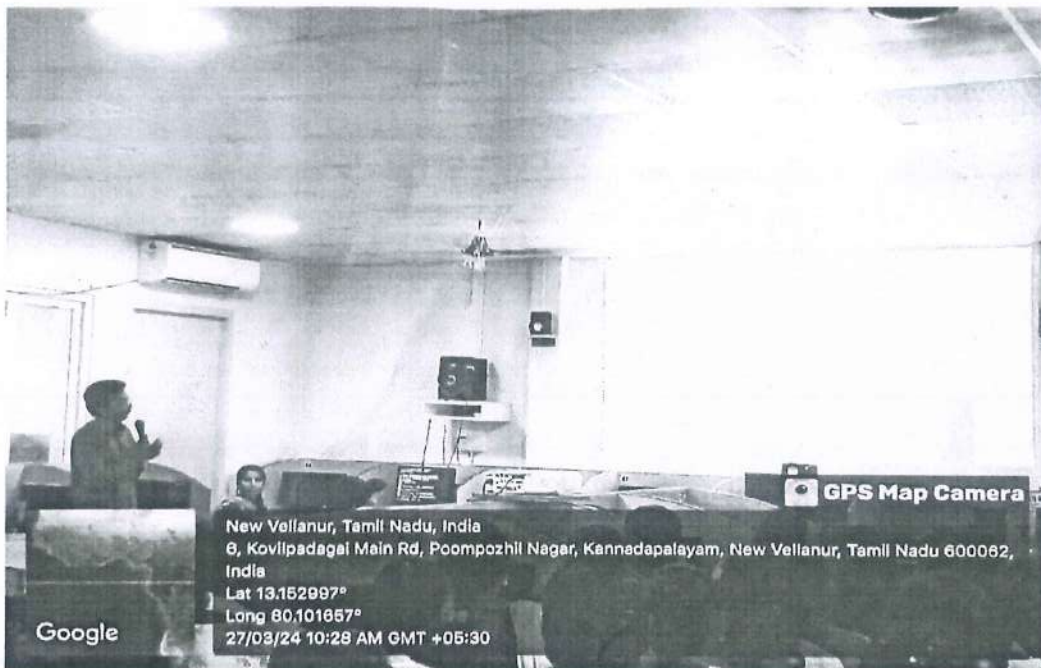
1. **Empathise:** Mr. Akash initiated the discussion by focusing on the 'Empathise' phase, underscoring the importance of understanding the user's needs, problems, and emotions. He shared captivating case studies where empathy led to groundbreaking innovations, reminding participants that successful designs are user-centric.
2. **Define:** Transitioning smoothly into the 'Define' phase, he stressed the necessity of articulating the user's needs and problems clearly. Through interactive exercises, he demonstrated how a well-defined problem is halfway to being solved.
3. **Ideate:** The 'Ideate' phase was presented not just as a step but as an open field for creativity. Mr. Akash encouraged participants to think beyond conventional boundaries and showcased methods to foster creativity within teams, using real-world examples where unconventional ideas led to remarkable solutions.

4. **Prototype:** As the heart of the workshop, the 'Prototype' phase was approached with comprehensive detail. Mr. Akash shared his experiences in developing prototypes, emphasizing the iterative process of creating, testing, and refining the product. The hands-on session allowed participants to engage in prototype development, offering a practical understanding of translating ideas into tangible forms.
5. **Test:** Finally, the 'Test' phase was addressed with the view that this stage is not the end but a part of an ongoing process of improvement. Mr. Akash shared insights on various testing methodologies, how to interpret feedback, and the importance of resilience in the face of setbacks.

Learning Outcome: Participants gained a deep understanding of the design thinking process, mastering the art of empathizing, defining, ideating, prototyping, and testing to turn innovative ideas into practical solutions.

While presenting some of his VFX works he explained many keywords like Invisible VFX, Rotomation, Planar tracking etc simply. His hard work, the curiosity to upscale his projects, and the accolades received in many studios motivated the audience. The projects he developed in the year 2016 and 2022 were presented to explain the students his transformation. During the session he expounded his exploration of the goal and encouraged them to tap into the power of imagination. As he had participated around 5 Rubix Cube Solvers in the World Cube Organisation, he suggested websites to learn algorithms and websites to participate in such events.

There was a question and answer session at the end of the programme. Finally the coordinator proposed a vote of thanks.



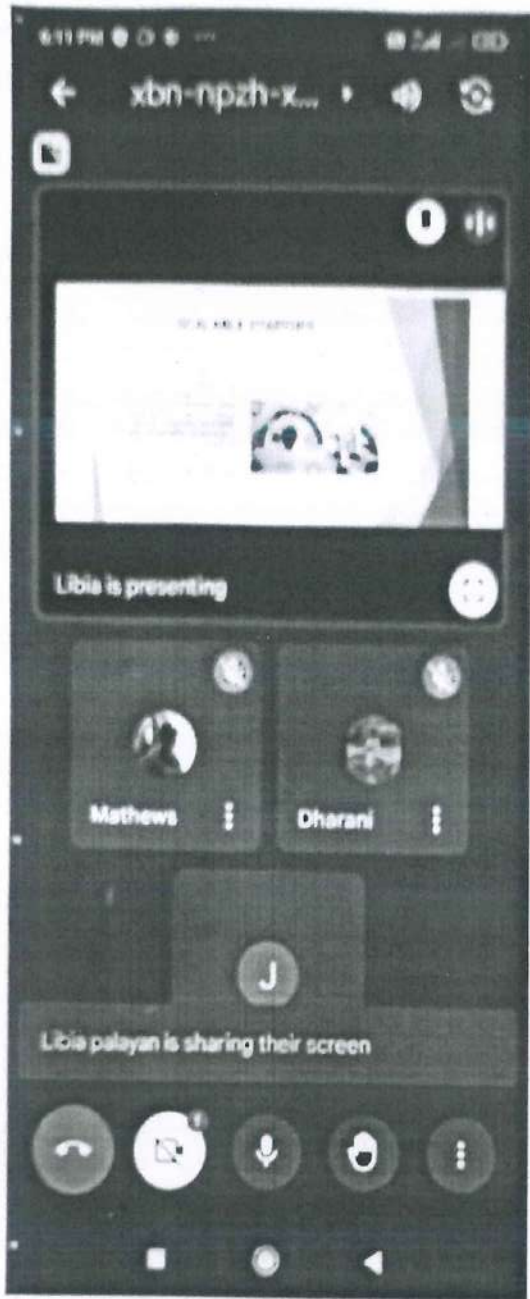

- Administrative support for legal and business-related tasks.



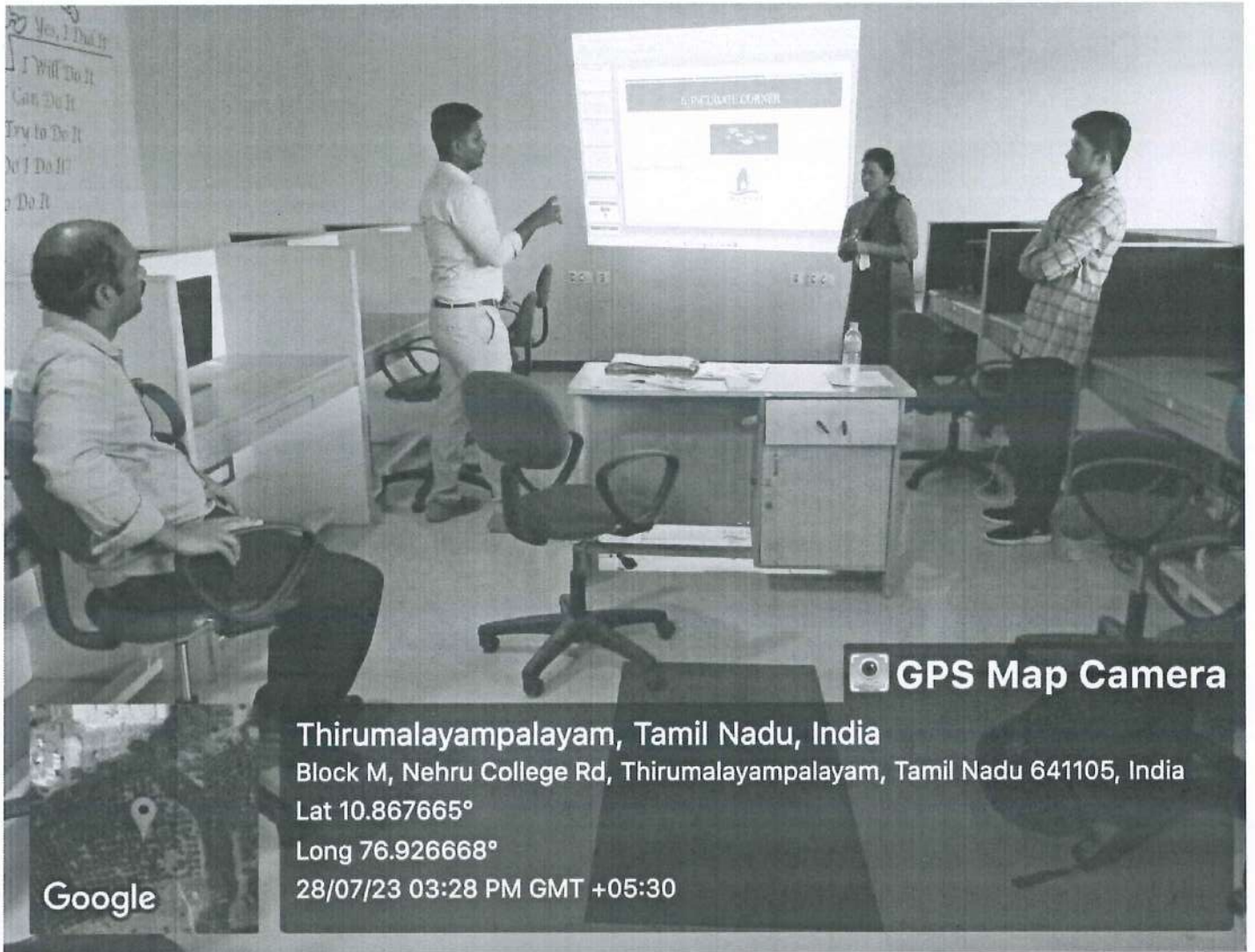
