




















# KITCHEN GARDEN PLANTATION



On Day 5, the students got split into four groups. The first group went for a survey to collect the information on the height and weight of the kids aged between 1 to 5 years in the Anganwadi. The second group set up a garden area in the school. The third group of students went along with faculty members to each class in the high school from 1st to 5th standard and gave an awareness speech about cleanliness. The fourth group continued their wall paintings on the school campus to spread awareness messages.

On Day 6, the finale of the NSS Special Camp, the focus was on spreading a message about avoiding the single use of plastic covers. The organizers made the school students assemble in a classroom.
