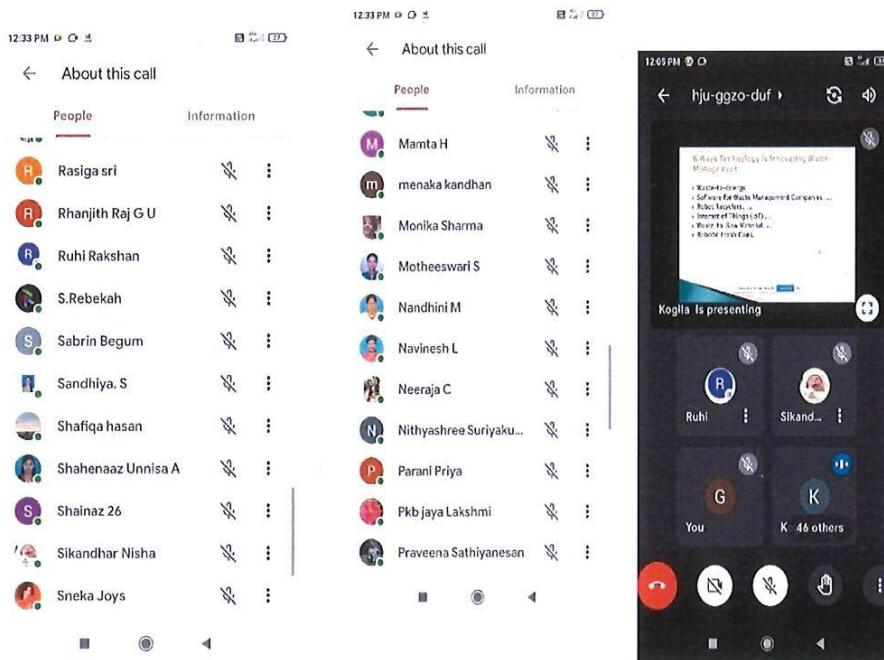

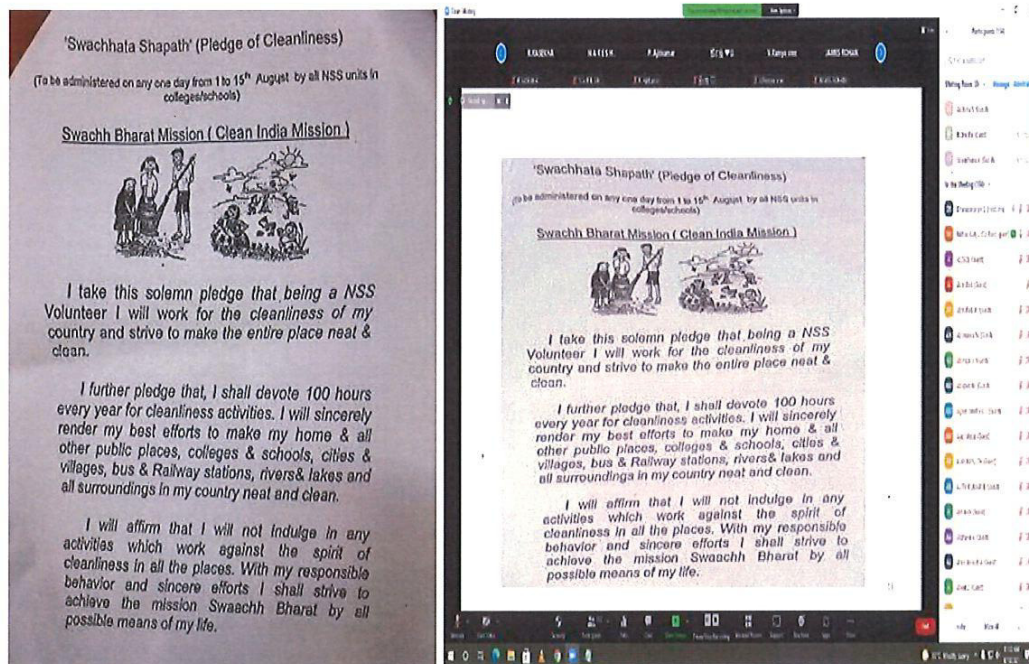

SWACHHTA PAKHWADA (FORTNIGHT) CLEANNESS

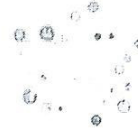

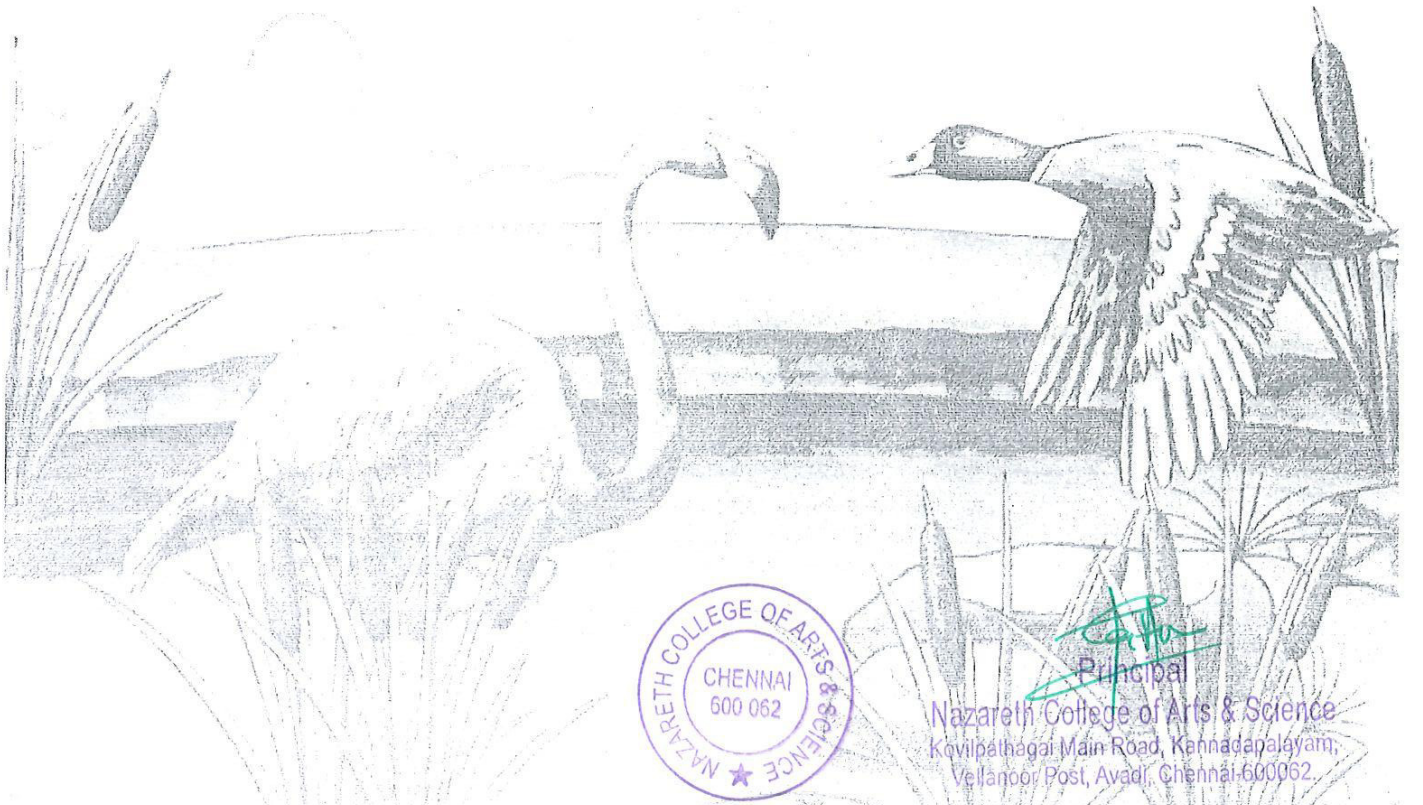
