
INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY

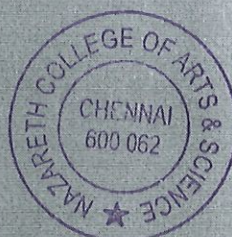
Report on World Youth Skills Day
