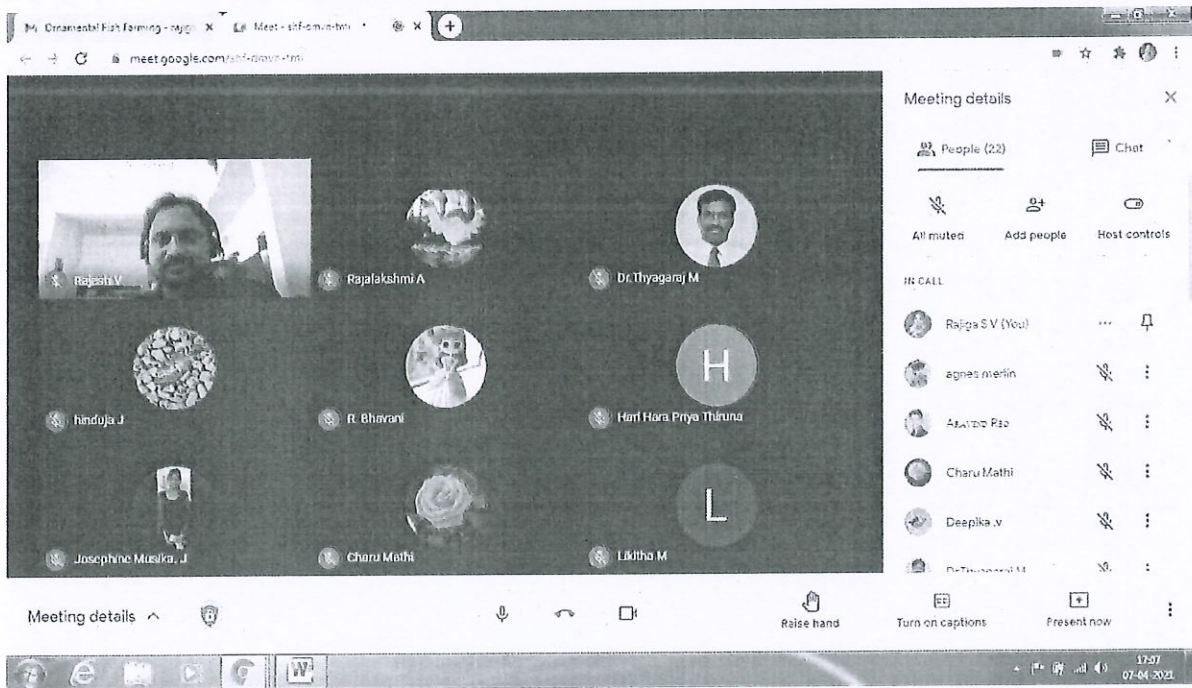
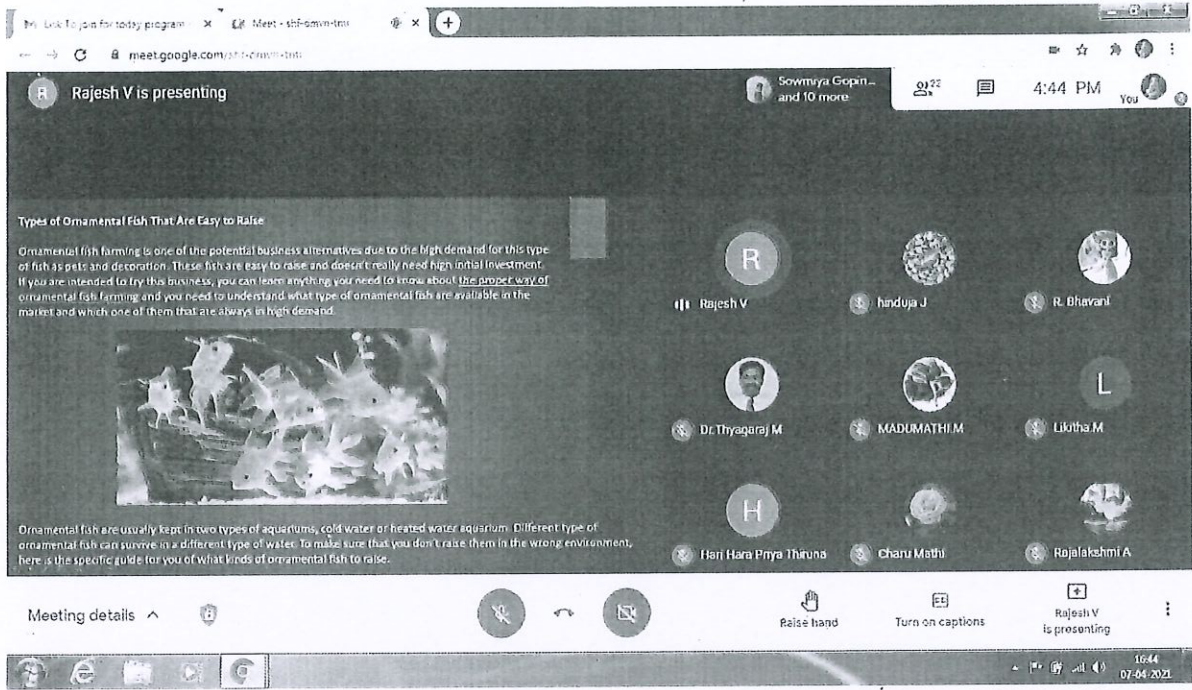
1. Voice on Python

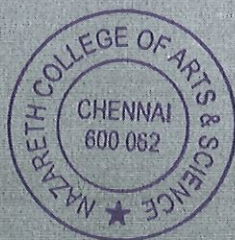
Awareness skit against drug abuse
