

Department of Computer Science Academic Year 2023 – 2024 Slow Learners Report

The Department of Computer Science conducted an analysis of slow learners in the First, Second, and Third years. This evaluation identified 21 students from I B.Sc CS, 19 students from II B.Sc CS, and 15 students from III B.Sc CS as slow learners based on their academic performance. The selection process was guided by teacher feedback to determine which students needed extra support. This approach effectively highlighted those who consistently underperformed and required additional assistance.

Actions Taken:

To help these students improve, several actions were taken:

Question Bank with Answers:

- A question bank with answers was provided for each unit. The bank included frequently asked questions from past exams with detailed answers.
- > Students were encouraged to read the questions and answers carefully and practice writing their own answers to improve their understanding.

• Regular Revision Sessions:

- Extra revision sessions were organized to go over difficult topics and answer students' questions.
- > These sessions gave students the chance to review key concepts and clarify doubts.

• Individual Consultations:

- > Students were offered one-on-one time with instructors to get personalized help with their studies.
- > Instructors addressed each student's specific difficulties and provided additional guidance.



Outcome:

These actions led to noticeable improvement in the students' academic performance. Most of the students were able to pass their exams, and their overall grades improved. They also became more confident and participated more in class discussions. Many students who had struggled before were now more engaged and motivated to continue learning. The use of question banks, along with personal guidance and regular monitoring, helped students catch up with their studies.
