


TOPIC: Puppetry Workshop





Quiz Club: Excelcior 2024- Inter-department Quiz Competition




Scrabble Club – Inter-department Scrabble Tournament




Book Reading Club: Read & Rewrite: an Inter Department Creative Writing Competition

Topic: Challenges and Opportunities for Students in the Modern Era of Education



HEALTH CARE CENTRE



SUBJECT ORIENTATION PROGRAM


