#### ABOUT THE CONFERENCE — SDG SUMMIT 2026 (BOTH OFFLINE/HYBRID)

The SDG Summit 2026, jointly organized by Nazareth College of Arts & Science and the International Network for Christian Higher Education, and powered by <a href="https://www.mapsdg.com">www.mapsdg.com</a>, will take place on February 20–21, 2026. The two-day international conference is themed "Sustainable Development Goals for People, Planet, and Prosperity" and seeks to bring together educators, researchers, policymakers, and community leaders to explore how higher education institutions can advance the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) through research, innovation, and community engagement.

This conference will follow a hybrid format, enabling international delegates to participate online, while Indian participants will attend in person.
